- Reviewed in 2021-22 to be endorsed in the SPREP 31<sup>st</sup> Meeting.



#### **Invasive Species Online tools**














- Online reporting tool following the Guidelines outline.

- Migrated from Access Database to online in 2022 – 2023










- Inform actions and supporting mechanisms in the region






PISI Informed the establishment of :

#### 2. Battler Resource Base


- a searchable knowledge portal developed to support NISCs, IS practitioners, environment managers, and partners




- IS online systems are integrated into one for ease of access

- Information and data has restricted access


